AWARD FOR EXCEPTIONAL APPRENTICE-TRAINING

Munich, in November 2017 – The city of Munich presented the Erasmus-Grasser Prize to Bruno Trost of Kältetechnik aircool GmbH and thus paid tribute to the outstanding contribution of the company he founded in 1986 as an outstanding apprentice training company.

Bruno Trost commented on the award ceremony with the words: "Kältetechnik aircool GmbH has repeatedly for over 20 years provided the best in their year Mechatronics for refrigeration and thus demonstrated their special achievement in the promotion of young people. Our continuously trained team could thereby successfully convey their expertise to the trainees and bring them up to a high level of professional practice." The Munich-based company has on several previous occasions been recognized by the Federal Guild Association of the German refrigeration equipment trade as best company of its kind in the training performance.
